In Ireland, people wear small bunches of shamrocks on their clothes to celebrate the holiday.

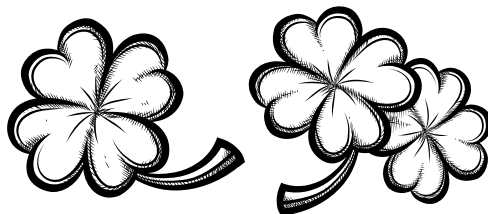
Children wear orange, white, and green badges, and women wear green ribbons.

Four-leaf clovers are considered lucky. Each leaf means something: hope, faith, love, and luck.

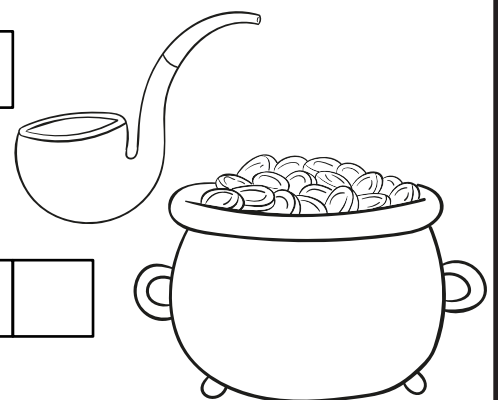
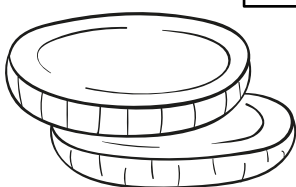
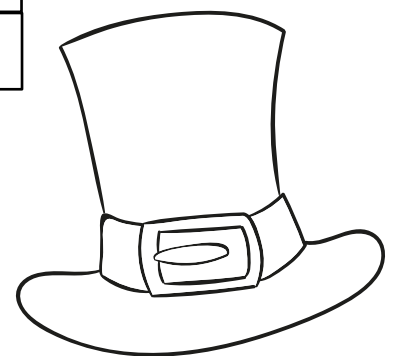
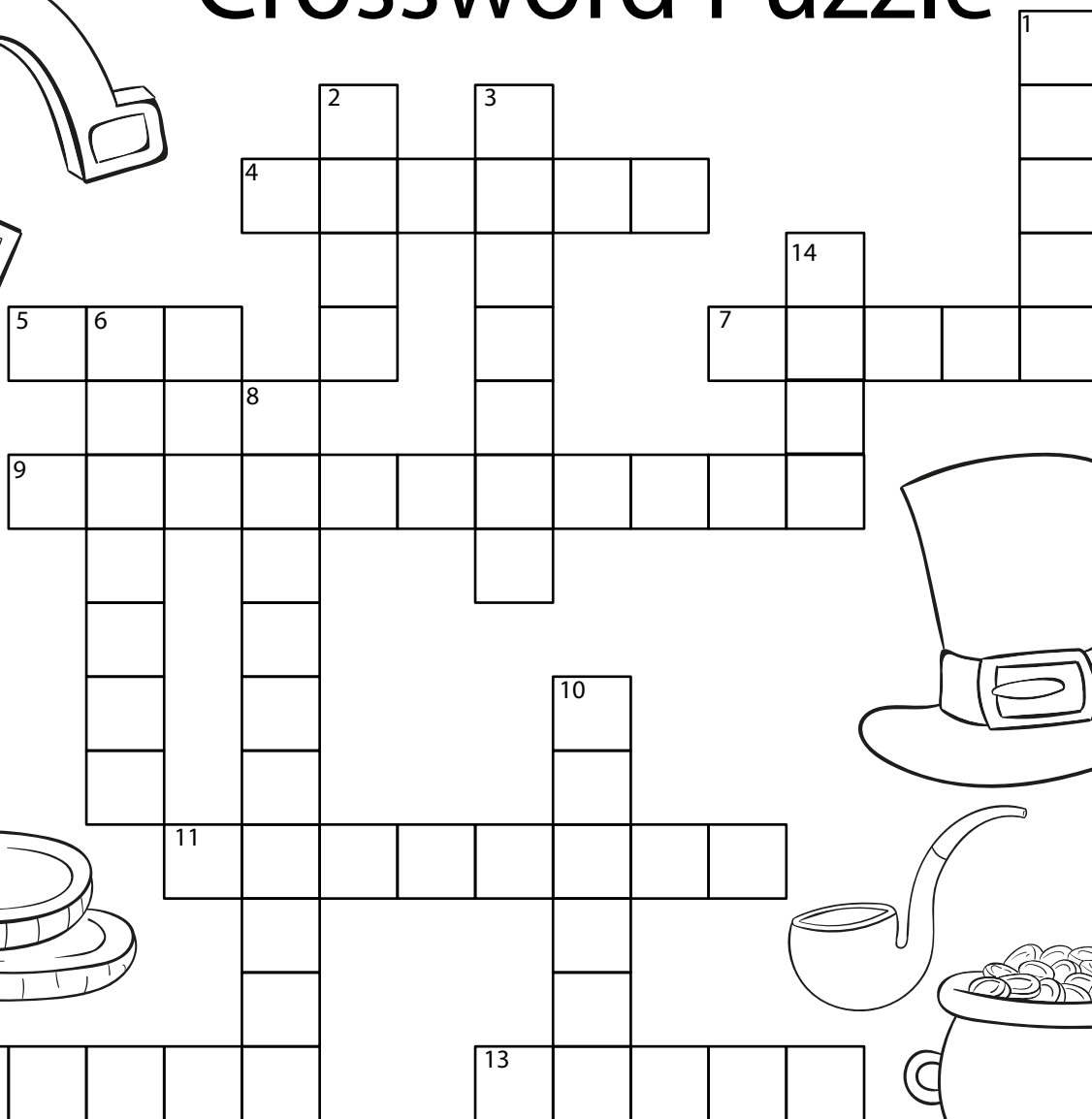
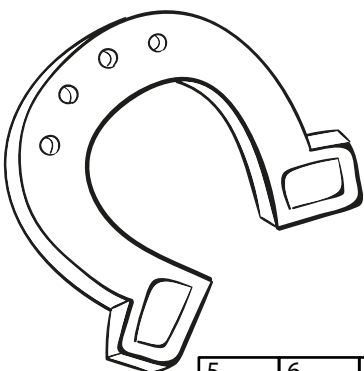
There are 10,000 three leaf clover for every four-leaf clover.
