

Handwriting Gift Ideas - click on blue links for a tutorial on a similar project

- Write "Aloe You Very Much". Cut out of vinyl and [add to succulent pot](#).
- Write "You are amazing, remember that". Cut out of vinyl and add to a mirror, [tile](#), or small sign.
- Write "You've Got This" or "you are so loved". Cut out of iron on vinyl and to [zipper pouch](#). Cut out of infusible ink and add to a [sublimation mug](#).
- Write "I love you" or "we love you". Cut out of vinyl and add to [ornament](#) or blank sign.
- Write "Sweet Dreams". Cut out of iron on vinyl or Infusible Ink and press onto [pillowcase](#).
- Write a favorite bible verse. Cut out of iron-on vinyl and add to the front of a [journal](#) or pillowcase.
- Write a favorite inspirational saying. Cut out of vinyl and add to acrylic or [resin keychain](#).
- Write "Please keep your water. Love, Mom". Cut out of permanent vinyl [and to a water bottle](#).
- Write "Never dull your sparkle". Cut out of HTV or adhesive vinyl and add to a jewelry case or little jewelry sack.
- Use an old recipe. Add to cutting board or [plate](#) with adhesive vinyl.
- There are so many cheap blanks from Dollar Stores. Cut out handwriting from old cards and add it to any hanging sign, the glass of an old frame, or little [chalkboard](#).
- Write "I'll love you forever, I'll like you for always, As long as I'm living, my baby you'll be" from the beloved book. Cut out of adhesive vinyl and [add to a glass block](#) to use as a night light. Or cut out of Infusible Ink and infuse it on a handmade [baby blanket](#).
- As a teacher gift, have your child write their teacher's name and add it to a [zipper pouch](#) or [Starbucks cup](#).
- Write your child's name. Cut out of iron-on vinyl and [add to a stuffed animal](#).
- Have your child write words to describe their Dad or Grandma. Cut out of iron on vinyl and [add to a shirt](#).
- Have your child write their names. Cut out of HTV and [add to a hat](#).
